What Else Can You Do?

1. When you have finished with your vacation brochures, pass them onto a friend or recycle them
2. Minimize waste by bringing your own water bottle and reusing it
3. Bring your own shopping bag (saving on bags for your purchases)
4. Buy local produce (which reduces air miles incurred in transporting the food for final preparation)

5. Please don't pick plants and flowers, leave them for others to enjoy
6. At your hotel use water sparingly, take short showers instead of baths and hang towels for drying and reuse
7. Separate paper from plastic and try to recycle as much as possible
8. Throw any litter in the bin and keep the local environment tidy
9. Switch lights off & air conditioning off if you are not in the room or don't need them
10. Turn off your TV instead of leaving it on standby
11. Leave as much packaging at home from goods you buy for your trip and recycle as much of this as possible
